Instructions for Public Participation for the December 12, 2022 Finance and Government Operations Committee meeting

• Virtual, Live Comments: To provide real time verbal public comment over Zoom, participants must sign up for public comment by 4:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting. • Note: Participants must sign up for public comment with the Zoom username or phone number that they will be entering the Zoom meeting with so that they can be identified when accessing the meeting.
