Instructions for Public Participation for the December 13, 2021 Finance and Government Operations Committee meeting

Committee members for review in advance of the meeting.

o Note: Participants must sign up for public comment with the Zoom username or phone number that they will be entering the Zoom meeting with so that they can be identified when accessing the meeting.
