What is ITS?

ITS Defined:

Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) means electronics, communications, or information processing used singly or in combination to improve the efficiency or safety of a surface transportation system

- ITS Purpose:
 - Improved Flow, Safety, System Efficiency



Planning and Deployment in the AMPA:

- 2030 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), ITS Element
 - Identifies Regional ITS Priorities
 - Total \$116 million
- Regional ITS Architecture
- ITS Projects in TIP
 - \$44.4 million in ITS Projects
 - City of Albuquerque Municipal Development –Traffic Management System
 - ABQRide Security, Dispatch, and Bus Stop improvements
 - NMDOT ITS Deployment Freeway and Traffic Management Center
- ITS Project Planning and Deployment Framework is in place
