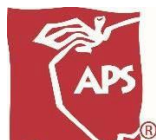

- **Virtual, Live Public Comment:** The LGCC will hear general public comments on a first-come, first-serve basis. To provide live public comment over Zoom, participants must sign up for public comment at using the [APS Public Comment Committee Form](#) by 3:30 p.m. the day of the LGCC meeting.

Note: If providing public comments via Zoom, speakers must enter the Zoom meeting with the name used to sign-up to speak so speakers can be identified and access the meeting remotely. A Zoom link will be e-mailed to remote participants immediately following completion of the [comment form](#).

Public Comment Rules: Each participant has two minutes to speak. Comments are to be addressed to the LGCC members only, through the Chair. Any disruptive conduct will result in removal from the meeting.

Remote participants will be an "Attendee" in the Zoom meeting until the public comment period begins. The moderator will move the speaker into the live meeting as a "Panelist" when prompted to provide comments.
