Instructions for Public Participation for the August 24th Finance and Government Operations Committee meeting.

- Written Comments: The Committee will take comment on the meeting's specific agenda items in written form via email through 1:00 pm on Monday, August 24. Web form submission for written comment can be found at www.cabq.gov/aug-24-2020-written. These comments will be distributed to all Committee members for review in advance of the meeting.
- Virtual, Live Comments: The Committee will take live public comment regarding the meeting's specific agenda items, from up to a maximum of 30 people, on a first-come first-serve basis. To provide real time verbal public comment over Zoom, participants must sign up for public comment by 1:00 p.m. on August 24th. The sign-up sheet can be accessed at this link:www.cabq.gov/aug-24-2020-live
- o Note: Participants must sign up for public comment with the Zoom username or phone number that you will use to enter the Zoom meeting so that you can be identified when accessing the meeting. Persons who do not provide this information will not be allowed into the meeting, but may still view the meeting via the YouTube live link.
- Participants will standby in the Zoom virtual waiting room until the live public comment period begins. The Zoom moderator will move all participants who have signed up for comment into the meeting room at that time.
