7	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF	
8	ALBUQUERQUE:	
9	Section 1. The City Council finds it necessary to overhaul the Police	
10	Oversight Ordinance and the functioning of the Police Oversight process and	
11	rules. To that end, the Council shall, prior to the end of calendar year 2013,	
12	hold public forums, conduct study sessions, provide staff and other resources,	
13	as necessary, and evaluate best practices nationwide in order to produce a	
14	revamped Police Oversight Ordinance that provides for prompt, impartial and	
15	fair investigation of all citizen complaints brought by individuals against the	
16	Albuquerque Police Department.	
17	Section 2. In order to take the first step towards the goal outlined in Section	
18	1 above, the following appropriation for fiscal year 2013 is hereby made from	
19	the unreserved fund balance in the General Fund 110 for the creation of a	
20	Management Analyst II position for the Independent Review Office:	
21	Department/Project Increase (Decrease)	
22	Chief Administrative Office 36,000	
23	Section 3. The City Council intends to fund this Management Analyst II	
24	position on a recurring basis beginning with the fiscal year 2014 budget cycle.
