❖ **Animal Welfare Trust Fund**

Establish the Animal Welfare Trust Fund, a sustainable funding source for animal shelters across the state, to support spay/neuter programs, animal care, and other essential resources for communities.

❖ **Poverty Solutions**

Develop programs to alleviate poverty, including the implementation of a Guaranteed Basic Income, raising the minimum wage, and enhancing workforce development opportunities.

❖ **Tenant Protections**

Strengthen tenant protections in New Mexico by implementing a Tenant's Bill of Rights and lifting the state's moratorium on rent stabilization.

❖ **Addiction Recovery Services**

Implement new addiction recovery services and build a statewide network to support individuals in recovery, irrespective of their income.

Establish new behavioral health services and create a statewide network to assist individuals with behavioral health needs, regardless of their income level.

❖ **Domestic Violence Victim Protections**

Pass laws and create services to ensure the safety and protection of victims of domestic violence

❖ **Gun Control**

Enact statewide gun control legislation to limit the types and quantities of firearms owned by civilians.

❖ **Immigrant Protections**

Enact legislation and secure necessary funding to offer support and legal protections for immigrants in New Mexico.”
