**FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO O-26-11 (Blueline)**

**AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY: Nichole Rogers**

1. On page 2, line 31 of the Blueline amend as follows:

**(A) The Board shall consist of ~~[15]~~ [17] voting members.**

2. On page 4, lines 27-30 of the Blueline amend as follows:

**(E) Quorum: Quorum shall consist of ~~[eight (8)]~~ [nine (9)] members, one of which shall be the Chair or Vice Chair.**

**(F) Voting: Decisions of the Board shall be made by a majority vote of the members present. [The Board shall not vote on matters unless a quorum of members are present as defined in subsection (E) above.]**

Explanation: This is a technical cleanup amendment that proposes to reflect that Board membership was increased from 15 to 17 via Floor Amendment 1, which was previously approved by the Council at the February 18 Council meeting. That approved amendment add two organizations—the NAACP Albuquerque Branch and the Albuquerque Public Schools African American Equity & Engagement Coordinator—as members on this Board. The amendment also adjusts the quorum from eight (8) to nine (9) members to reflect the addition of two organizations.

**FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.   2   TO O-26-11 (Blueline)**

**AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY: Nichole Rogers**

1. On page 1, line 14, amend as follows:

**WHEREAS, ~~black~~ **[Black]** communities experience disproportionate rates of violence, disappearance, unresolved cases, and insufficient systemic response related to missing and murdered Black people, resulting in ongoing harm to families and communities; and**

Explanation: This amendment capitalizes the word “Black” to reflect that the term is used as a proper noun referring to people of African descent, consistent with editorial standards adopted by major style guides and news organizations.

1. On page 5, line 1 of the Blueline amend as follows:

**(H) Bylaws [and Policies and Procedures]: The Board shall adopt bylaws [and policies and procedures] consistent with City requirements governing meeting procedures, officer roles, voting, and Board operations. [Bylaws and policies and procedures shall be adopted within the Board's first year of operation, shall be reviewed on an annual basis, and updated as necessary.]**

Explanation: This amendment proposes to require the Board to create Policies and Procedures in addition to Bylaws. The first set of Bylaws and Policies and Procedures would need to be drafted with in the first year of the Board's operations and would be reviewed and updated regularly.
