COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO O-26-25

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY Joaquín Baca

1. On page 3, line 26 amend Section § 14-8-8-5-A BOARD COMPOSITION, APPOINTMENT, AND TERMS as follows:

(1) ~~Three (3)~~ ~~Four (4)~~ members-at-large shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council.

~~One (1) member-at-large shall be appointed by the City Council.~~

~~Three (3)~~ ~~Two (2)~~ One (1) member shall be appointed by the City Council. The Council shall appoint one (1) community representative per designated TIF District.

Explanation: This amendment proposes to adjust the number of members-at-large appointed by the Mayor to three appointments down from four.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO O-26-25

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY Joaquín Baca

1. On page 3, line 28 amend Section § 14-8-8-5-2 BOARD COMPOSITION, APPOINTMENT, AND TERMS as follows:

(2) One (1) member shall be **[a community representative]** appointed by the City Council. The Council shall appoint one (1) community representative per designated TIF District.

[(a) If a TIF District is exclusively within the boundary of one City Council district, the Councilor for that district shall nominate their preferred candidate for confirmation by the City Council.]

[(b) If the boundary of a TIF District includes more than one City Council district, the Councilors representing that TIF District shall jointly nominate the community representative for confirmation by the City Council. In the event that the Councilors representing that TIF District cannot reach a consensus, those Councilors may each nominate one preferred candidate for confirmation by the City Council using preferential balloting.]

[(c)] [~~(a)~~] The designated community representative for a designated TIF District shall have voting rights on administrative and general actions taken by the board and TIF Projects within the TIF District they represent.

[(d)] [~~(b)~~] In no case shall a designated community representative represent more than one TIF District concurrently.

Explanation: This amendment proposes to establish Council's process for nominating the community representative member of a TIF Board. When a TIF District falls within

one Council district, the Councilor for that district will nominate their proposed candidate for confirmation by the full Council.

If a TIF District spans multiple Council districts, the Councilors representing that area can either (1) jointly nominate an agreed-upon community representative for confirmation by the full Council, or (2) submit their own individual preferred candidate for final selection by the City Council. Pursuant to the City Council Rules of Procedure, the appointment will be completed using preferential balloting, in which all nine Councilors will indicate the order of their preference with their first preference receiving a 1, their second receiving a 2, and their third receiving a 3.
