FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO O-26-5

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY: Joaquín Baca

1. On page 2, line 16, amend as follows:

(2) An STR permit shall not be approved if it is located within [330] [100] feet in all directions of another approved STR Permit.

Explanation: This amendment proposes to reduce the buffer distance between short term rental permits to 100 feet from 330 feet.

1. On page 2, line 25, amend as follows:

[330] [100]

Explanation: This amendment proposes to revise all sections of the bill to reflect the change adopted in floor amendment A that reduce the distance separation between STR permits from 330 feet to 100 feet.

1. On page 2, line 14, amend as follows:

(1) The separation requirements contained in this Section 13-19-6(D) shall apply within the [municipal boundaries of the city] [boundaries of Council Districts 2, 6, and 7 only].

Explanation: This amendment proposes limiting the application of the separation requirement to Council Districts 2, 6, and 7, rather than applying citywide.
