FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO OC-25-51

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY: Nichole Rogers

1. In the attachment at the Heading for Each Council District add the name of the Councilor for that District.

Explanation: Legislators know a Council District by the name of the person who is serving as the City Councilor for the District, not by the number of the District. By adding the name of the City Councilor, a legislator is more likely to identify a request with its location.

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FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO OC-25-51

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY: Nichole Rogers

In the section of the attachment for City Council District 6 Capital Outlay Request, make the following changes.

1. Delete the request for "Mobile Hygiene Trailers".
2. Delete the request for "City Council District 6-Traffic Calming" and replace with a new request as follows:
"City Council District 6-Traffic Calming On 10 Residential Streets-Participatory Budgeting.
Plan, Design, Acquire Right-Of-Way, Equip, And Construct Traffic Safety Improvements To Residential Streets In City Council District 6 in Albuquerque."
3. Delete the request "City Council District 6-Highland Multigenerational Center" and replace with the following:
"City Council District 6 - Multigenerational Center.
Plan, Design, Equip, Renovate, Construct A Multigenerational Center in City Council District 6 in Albuquerque".
4. Delete the request "Walmart Property Acquisition" and replace with the following:
"City Council District 6-Vacant Property Acquisition.
"Acquire Vacant Nuisance Properties, Including But Not Limited To, Vacant Walmart, CVS, And Walgreens Retail Outlets In The International District To Develop Mixed-Use/Multi-Use Developments In The International District In Albuquerque."
5. Delete the request "Public Safety Equipment" and replace with the following:
"District 6 Public Safety Equipment.
Plan, Design, Acquire, Equip, And Install Automated Speed Cameras And Trailers On Central Avenue Between Girard Avenue And Eubank Boulevard And Other Key Areas in City Council District 6."
6. Delete the request "Real Time Crime Center" and replace with the following:
"Real Time Crime Center.

Plan, Design, Acquire, Equip, And Install Technology At The Real Time Crime Center In Albuquerque And In City Council District 6, Specifically To Support Public Safety.”

7. At the end of the list of District 6 capital outlay requests insert the following:
“* The Requests Listed As “Participatory Budgeting” Were Identified As Community Priorities In City Council District 6 Through An FY-25 Participatory Budgeting Process.”

Explanation: Adjust the titles and scopes of capital outlay requests in City Council District 6 to better define the requests and adds a note to remind the legislative delegation that certain requests are part of the funding program for the FY25 Participatory Budgeting Initiative.
