FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO P-24-1

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY COUNCILOR: Fiebelkorn

1. On page 2, starting on line 19, amend Section 4 as follows:

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This proposition is effective immediately. The Charter Amendment described in SECTION 1 of this proposition shall take effect on January 1, ~~2025~~ 2026, so long as certified as approved by the voters.

Explanation: This amendment proposes to change the effective date of this measure, if it is approved by the voters, from January 1st, 2025 to January 1st, 2026

FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO P-24-1

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY COUNCILOR Klarissa J. Peña

1. On page 1, line 20 Strike “Forty Percent” replace with “No”
2. On page 1, line 23 strike “, provide the number of votes equals or exceeds [40%] of the **total number of votes cast for the office**”
3. On page 2, line 1 strike “no candidate receives 50%” replace with “two or more candidates tie for the most votes received”
4. On page 2, line 5 strike “two candidates who receive”
5. On page 2, line 5 insert “candidates who tied with”

Explanation: This amendment makes it so that whatever candidate receives the most votes for any office wins. This amendment removes the minimum percentage of votes received for a candidate to be elected. It also changes the runoff procedure to only apply in the event of a tie between two or more candidates.
