**Amendment 1**: Beginning on page 2, line 1, replace Section 2 as follows:

[TIME PERIOD OF PILOT PROGRAM. Utilizing a rolling admission model, the Pilot Program is designed to provide individuals with twelve (12) months of housing assistance. Upon conclusion of the twelve-month period, at the City's discretion, the participant may request up to an additional six (6) months to maintain the voucher while completing the transition into stable housing.]

Explanation: This amendment clarifies that a Pilot Program participant can request to stay on the Continuing Sobriety Housing Voucher (CSV) for up to an additional six months while completing the transition into stable housing.

**Amendment 2**: Beginning on page 2, line 7, replace Section 3 as follows:

[SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. Opioid Settlement Funds in the amount of \$1,263,900 are hereby appropriated from Fund 201 to the Department of Health, Housing, and Homelessness for the purpose of establishing and operating the Sobriety Housing Voucher Pilot Program for the duration of the Pilot Program. Funds not used within the time period shall revert to Fund 201.]

Sobriety Housing Voucher Pilot Program \$1,263,900]

Explanation: This amendment increases the appropriation for the CSV to reflect the additional 6 months participants may use the voucher.
