**Explanation:**

This amendment restores some funding to the General Services Department for City

Facilities Rehab, to maintain and rehabilitate our existing facilities as required by the CIP Ordinance. This amount is pulled from various other Facility renovation funding allocations. The amount allocated to that specific salt shed is insufficient to complete the project. The East Central Pedestrian Safety Improvements from Louisiana to Eubank is a former Vision Zero project that is already fully funded.

**Amended on the dais:** Changes made are reducing the amount in #1 by \$1m, adding #2 to add language after Line 3 on Page 6, and striking #5 entirely.
