FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO R-26-29 Blueline

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY: Nichole Rogers & Joaquín Baca

1. On page 3, lines 11 through 14, amend SUMMARY as follows:

This proposition would amend the City's existing Public Safety Gross Receipts Tax to dedicate funds to the following uses: Police ~~[35%]~~[40%]; Fire/Emergency Preparedness ~~[35%]~~[40%]; Code Enforcement ~~[5%]~~[3%]; Albuquerque Community Safety ~~[25%]~~[15%]; Animal Welfare Department 2%.

2. On page 3, lines 18 through 22, amend TITLE AND PROPOSITION as follows:

Shall the City of Albuquerque update the dedication of the existing one-quarter of one percent Public Safety Gross Receipts Tax to dedicate funds specifically and only for the following uses: Police ~~[35%]~~[40%]; Fire/Emergency Preparedness ~~[35%]~~[40%]; Code Enforcement ~~[5%]~~[3%]; Albuquerque Community Safety ~~[25%]~~[15%]; Animal Welfare Department 2%. This is an update to an existing tax. This will not increase the tax rate.

Explanation: This amendment expands the proposed update to the Public Safety Gross Receipts Tax dedication to include Animal Welfare (AWD) as an eligible public safety function. The amendment adjusts the dedication to Police and Fire/Emergency Preparedness to 40% each, ACS to 15%, Code Enforcement to 3%, and dedicates 2% to Animal welfare.
