1. Beginning on page 4, line 23, add the following Whereas clauses as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Application and has determined that proceeding further with the formation of the District is consistent with the PID Ordinance and promotes the interests, convenience or necessity of the owners, residents of the District and citizens of the City of Albuquerque [: and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that the Public Improvement District Ordinance was adopted in 2003 and that housing affordability, fiscal sustainability, water stewardship, conservation practices, and broader community priorities have evolved significantly since that time; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Resolution should not be construed as limiting the authority of the City Council to consider future amendments to the City's Public Improvement District policies to better align with current community needs and policy objectives].

Explanation: This amendment emphasizes that the City Council should work toward modernization efforts of the PID Ordinance.
