Integrated Development Ordinance Updates

The Integrated Development Ordinance (IDO) was adopted by the City Council on November 13th, 2017. This followed a total of five meetings at the Environmental Planning Commission, four meetings by the Land Use, Planning and Zoning Committee, and three meetings at the full City Council. There were amendments made at every phase of the process.

Upcoming IDO Public Meetings

Individual amendments can be found on the project webpage, here. A final document that incorporates all amendments through the final City Council meeting on November 13th can be found here.

The document goes into effect on May 17th, 2018 (six months after

the publication date). Between now and May 17th, the intention of the project team is to continue meeting with the community to explain the document, answer questions, and take feedback on further improvements. There will be meetings held in all of the Community Planning Assessment areas over the next several months. These informational sessions, along with the interal staff trainings that Planning is conducting will help to catch any errors or overlooked content in the IDO. There will be a packet of amendments to the IDO before May 17th to correct any of these errors and ommissions that were not caught during the initial adoption phase and to do a general

"clean up" of the document.
