**Projecting Particles with STEM+Arts**

Explore particle physics and projection art with STEM + Arts teacher, new media artist and Sube, Inc. founder Agnes Chavez. Students will have the opportunity to virtually travel to Geneva and get a virtual tour of CERN's ATLAS Detector located in the Large Hadron Collider and be able to connect iPads to each other and to projectors for multiplayer paint projection sessions using the Tagtool App. This workshop is part of the STEM + Arts program for *Digital Latin America*, hosted by the National Hispanic Cultural Center and produced through a collaboration between the NHCC and 516 ARTS.
