WHEREAS, profits from the marching band competition are returned to the Albuquerque Public Schools High School Band Programs; and

WHEREAS, marching band is a part of a complete education, engages students in individual and group activity, develops creativity, promotes leadership skills, problem solving, critical and evaluative skills; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that a day should be set apart this year to celebrate the 35th annual competition and for the purpose of recognizing current members, alumni, current and former band directors, and current and former parent volunteers of the New Mexico Pageant of Bands.


