WHEREAS, the NCAA Division I Indoor Track and Field Championships were held in Albuquerque, New Mexico on March 14th and 15th, 2014 at the Albuquerque Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, through the collaborative partnership between the City of Albuquerque Parks and Recreation Department, the Albuquerque Convention Center, the University of New Mexico Athletics Department and the Albuquerque Convention and Visitors Bureau, this event was a huge success; and

WHEREAS, hosting this prestigious national championship brings positive attention to the City of Albuquerque and showcases its best assets, creating potential for more visitors in the future; and

WHEREAS, the University of New Mexico Athletics Department secured the bid to host the 2014 NCAA Men's and Women's Indoor Track and Field Division I National Championships; and

WHEREAS, ACVB reports that this event brought 1,600 attendees and 3,018 room nights generating \$1 million in direct spending; and

WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Convention Center accommodated over 520 athletes from 134 different schools during the NCAA Division I Indoor Track and Field Championships; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque Parks and Recreation Department has maintained and supported the indoor track for a period of 9 years and continued to keep it in the professional condition necessary to host a national championship.
