

<u>Construction Update: Water Line Relocation on Central between Coors</u> <u>And Old Coors to Wrap Up Next Week; Construction Has Begun</u> <u>On Central between Atrisco & Sunset</u>

NOTE: All construction is weather permitting and subject to change without notice.

NOTE: Crews will not be working Friday, Sept. 2 or Monday, Sept. 5, in observance of the Labor Day holiday. All traffic barricades (except those in the area of removed medians) will be picked up from Central between Coors and Old Coors, and barricades will remain on Central between Atrisco and Sunset.

Wednesday, August 31-Friday Sept. 2, 2016


Crews should complete replacement of water lines on the south side of Central from west of Estancia to west of 64th Street as well as grouting of lines to be abandoned. <u>THIS AREA IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED</u> AND FULLY OPEN BY FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2016.

Tuesday, Sept. 6 & Wednesday, Sept. 7, 2016 (TWO DAYS ONLY)

Crews will complete final construction on the north side of Central. The westbound right lane will be closed from west of 57th to Yucca for this work.

Continuing through Friday, September 16, 2016

Crews are installing a 6-inch waterline on the south side of Central Avenue between Atrisco and Sunset. During this work, eastbound traffic on Central will be reduced to two lanes from west of Atrisco to Sunset.



Traffic will be able to turn left, heading south on both Atrisco and Sunset during construction.

NOTE: After completion of this part of the project, crews will halt construction due to the Balloon Fiesta Moratorium, then return to install a new 12inch waterline in this area between October 10 and early November in advance of the holiday construction moratorium. More information will be provided in advance of that construction.

Regular Work hours will be 7 a.m.-7 p.m. Monday-Friday, although crews may work longer hours or on weekends if needed.
