R-2016-032 COUNCIL BILL NO. \_\_\_\_\_C/S R-16-15 SPONSORED BY: **Dan Lewis** 1 RESOLUTION 2 **ESTABLISHING THE POLICY OF IMPLEMENTATION FOR THE PUBLIC** 3 SERVICE ETHICS AND CODE OF CONDUCT TRAINING PROGRAM FOR THE 4 CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE AND DIRECTING THE CITY HUMAN RESOURCES 5 AND LEGAL DEPARTMENTS TO OVERSEE THE PROGRAM. WHEREAS, the one year objectives, outlined in Resolution 15-182 for the 6 City of Albuquerque in Fiscal Year 2016, directs the implementation of this 7 8 comprehensive ethics training program in order to reaffirm that the City is dedicated to fostering an environment of fairness and accountability in all of 9 10 its dealings; and 11 WHEREAS, the goal of this public service ethics course is to act as a Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 resource to the public servants of the City of Albuquerque, and to reaffirm that the official acts of the elected officials and employees of the City of 13 Albuquerque, as well as the official acts of the members of the City's boards, 14 commissions and committees, must be performed in such a manner as to gain 15 16 and retain the confidence and trust of the public; and 17 WHEREAS, The City of Albuquerque Public Service University provides 18 strategic blended learning delivery systems that support the attainment of 19 prescribed organizational and community based goals and can support the 20 public service ethics training program in-house; and WHEREAS, the proper administration of democratic government requires 21 22 that public officials be independent, impartial, and responsible to the people; 23 that government decisions and policy be made in the best interest of the 24 people, the community and the government; and that the public have 25 confidence in the integrity of its government.

1	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
2	ALBUQUERQUE:
3	Section 1. Program Administration and Enrollment.
4	The Public Service Ethics and Code of Conduct Training Program shall be
5	administered by the Human Resources Department. All designated City
6	officials, elected officials, classified staff in a position grade of "M14" and
7	"E14" and above, and all executive and senior level unclassified staff, and all
8	department records custodians will be enrolled in the program following the
9	certification of each regular municipal election. Beginning in 2017, all
10	designated officials and staff shall receive course login information through
11	their City email accounts from the City of Albuquerque Public Service
12	University no later than January 1 <sup>st</sup> of the year following a regular municipal
13	election year.
14	Section 2. Program Completion Requirements.
15	All persons designated under Section 1 above shall be required to complete
16	the Public Service Ethics and Code of Conduct Training Program by January
17	31 <sup>st</sup> of the year immediately following a regular municipal election. All
18	completed certifications will be valid for two years.
19	Section 3. Course Completion Publication.
20	Course Completion or non-completion will be noted by the name of each
21	person designated under Section 1 above on the "Transparency" portal on the
22	City of Albuquerque's main website. The Human Resources Department is
23	hereby directed to update and manage this information by the end of the
24	second quarter of the year following a regular municipal election cycle.
25	Section 4. New Employees.
26	All newly employed persons designated under Section 1 above shall be
27	required to complete the Public Service Ethics and Code of Conduct Training
28	Program 30 days after their date of hire. All completed certifications will be
29	valid until after the next regular municipal election. Course Completion or non-
30	completion will be noted according to Section 3 above.
31	Section 5. Program Content Updates.
32	The Human Resources Department and Legal Department are hereby directed

to work in conjunction to periodically update the Public Service Ethics and

	•	ode of conduct framing Frogram content to reliect any necessary revisions						
	2	and include any additional resources that are deemed pertinent to the training.						
	3	Section 6. Pilot Program.						
	4	A Public Service Ethics and Code of Conduct Training pilot program shall go						
	5	into effect May 9, 2016. Under this pilot program all persons designated in						
	6	Exhibit A shall receive course login information through their City email						
	7	accounts from the City of Albuquerque Public Service University no later than						
	8	May 9, 2016, and shall complete the Public Service Ethics and Code of						
	9	Conduct Training Program by June 30, 2016. Course Completion or non-						
	10	completion will be noted by the name of each person designated in Exhibit A						
	11	on the "Transparency" portal on the City of Albuquerque's main website by						
	12	August of 2016. The permanent program described in Sections 1-5 above						
	13	shall become effective after the 2017 regular municipal election.
