Bond Community [+Bracketed/Underscored Material+] - New Revitalization Set Aside Project, activity number 7395120, states that one of the purposes of this funding is to acquire land for projects associated with redevelopment activity in defined centers and corridors and/or in blighted [-Bracketed/Strikethrough Material-] areas of the City; and WHEREAS, the project description also states that adjacent neighborhoods shall be involved by the implementing agencies in the planning and construction of these projects; and WHEREAS, there is an unencumbered fund balance sufficient to make the appropriation outlined below; and WHEREAS, in FY/06, the City Council reserved \$4.075 million for the City Council to cover increased fuel costs in FY/06; and WHEREAS, per the FY/06 Year-End Clean-up bill now before the Council (R-06-141), \$2.774 million is unreserved and appropriated for excess fuel costs 24 for FY/06, leaving a total of \$1.301 million available to be unreserved and 25 utilized for another purpose; and 26
