WHEREAS, the acquisition and redevelopment of the Railyard Property is 6 critical for the revitalization and economic health of the Barelas Neighborhood 7 8 as well as the Downtown area; and WHEREAS, the state and the Wheels Museum have provided funding and 9 support for the acquisition and redevelopment of the property; and 10 WHEREAS, the City has already provided \$2.25 million in funding for the 11 letion [+ Bracketed/Underscored Material +] - New acquisition effort and is desirous of providing additional funds; and 12 _ □ 13 WHEREAS, the City has available to it funds in the Housing and Neighborhood Economic Development Fund (Fund 277), half of which are to acketed/Strikethrough Material-] be used for economic development purposes in pockets of poverty such as the Barelas neighborhood; and WHEREAS, one of the stated goals of the Housing and Neighborhood Economic Development Fund Plan is to "help eliminate blighted conditions in the Pocket of Poverty to create a sound environment for public and private investment, commercial revitalization, and neighborhood stabilization mainly through improving physical conditions"; and WHEREAS, the acquisition of the railyard property and its redevelopment is an ideal project for this funding; and 23 WHEREAS, the City has reserved six hundred fifty nine thousand dollars 24 (\$659,000) within the General Fund from the Phillips Semiconductor Industrial 25 Revenue Bond clawback agreement; and 26
