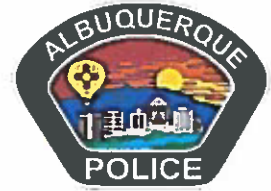

This memorandum serves to convey the articulation for APD's points of non-concurrence in the above captioned administrative investigation conducted by the Civilian Police Oversight Agency.

1-1-6-C-1	Sustained/Written Reprimand	Exonerated


Rationale for non-concurrence of action for 1-1-6-C-1:

Commanders Waite and Landavazo both reviewed this case and determined Officer H [redacted] actions did not violate this policy. Both commanders agree Officer H [redacted] did complete a police report and made reasonable attempts to contact the offender and witnesses. Officer H [redacted] was not able to reach any of the other parties, which made him unable to file a summons correctly. Officer H [redacted] also explained in his report why the summons was not filed. I agree with the findings of Commanders Waite and Landavazo.

Conclusion:

Based on my assessment of the facts derived from this investigation, I have deemed it appropriate to exonerate this violation.
