I continued to make the million calls I had to do in order to close and open account, change direct deposits, figure out how to send bills if post office mailboxes are no longer safe, etc.

An officer arrived at 1:30. It was George Garcia, man#2742. He was polite, patient, and very professional. He walked me through the report process, and told me everything I needed to do. While it was completely unnecessary, he waited in his car while I worked on the paperwork. I suppose that was because I was home alone.

Again, I acknowledge that you all have more important things to do, this was more than extremely important to me and very helpful. I wish the rest of the process was going to work so smoothly. I hope that the information I had on the checks will help to find this person.

I have family in law enforcement and I have enormous respect for all you do. Thank you from the bottom of my heart. If you can identify the girl/women on the phone, please also pass along my thanks to her.
