Dear APD Chief Gorden Eden, and the Civilian Police Oversight Committee,

I am an individual with severe Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) as a result of

. On the evening of Monday, March 27, 2017, I was away from home when I was triggered and suddenly found myself in an acute PTSD episode. My own memory of the incident is fairly fuzzy, as is typical for me during these episodes, but this is what I've been able to piece together afterwards:

When I was triggered, I panicked and bolted from the building I was in. In the process, I got separated from my highly-trained service dog, who is vital in keeping me oriented to my surroundings and "in the present moment" among many other trained, disability-specific tasks. My service dog is always by my side, so being separated from her not only prevented her from doing her job, but also removed the main way I can keep myself oriented aware of what's happening in present-day.

Unfortunately, this isn't the first time I've had one of these acute PTSD episodes where I bolt and go hide somewhere. I seem to run in straight lines, along edges of buildings, away from busy streets and open areas, and go hide in the first corner or small space I find. This is apparently exactly what I did this time too; I ran away from the area, and eventually hid in a group of trees & bushes in a nearby neighborhood.

As soon as the healthcare provider I was seeing at the time of the incident couldn't find me outside, she called police to help find me. Officer Cody Maxwell (unknown badge number) was the responding officer.

Officer Maxwell searched nearby neighborhoods for me, stopping anyone he saw along the street to ask if they had seen me. Somehow, he was able to spot me hiding in a clump of trees, barely visible from the street. I have extreme fears of men, strangers of any gender, being alone in a car with someone else, and of police officers – yet somehow Officer Maxwell was able to make me feel safe enough to successfully convince me to get into his patrol car so he could bring me back to my healthcare provider, where I was reunited with my service dog.

My service dog started doing a "Squish" task of deep-pressure therapy, which helps bring me out of these episodes. Instead of immediately calling for EMS services and/or taking me to a hospital (which would have been the faster and more convenient option for him), Officer Maxwell stayed with me and my therapist until I started to come around and be more responsive and more oriented to my surroundings, at which time he determined that I could safely be released into the care of a trusted friend, instead of going to the hospital. am very grateful that he was willing to take the extra time to stay with me instead of choosing to hospitalize me out of convenience or time. If I had been whisked away by ambulance, physically assessed by EMS personnel and taken to a hospital surrounded by even more strangers, it would have been significantly traumatizing for me, and would have ultimately made things far worse for me in the end. Officer Maxwell's patience and willingness to "go the extra mile" prevented an already stressful and scary situation from becoming much worse for me.

Although I have absolutely no history of aggression, violence, or combativeness, I have always been incredibly fearful of encountering police during a PTSD episode, and becoming the next "James Boyd" if my behavior is misconstrued by responding officers as defiance or uncooperativeness.

I know that APD has been making a significant effort in recent years to improve police officer training and outcomes for encounters with citizens with mental health issues. I'd like to think that the encounter I had with Officer Maxwell is either a result of this improved training, or that I was lucky enough to have an officer whose own inherent patience and compassion cause a successful outcome for all involved.

Please recognize Officer Maxwell for a job well done.

The information provided in this statement is true and factual to the best of my knowledge and will become public record once filed.

I understand I may be required to appear in the Civilian Police Oversight Agency office for an interview or to provide other investigative assistance, as necessary.

I understand that if I file a complaint, it is unlawful and against APD Policies for anyone to retaliate against me for the filing of this complaint.

Statement

My husband, _____, was involved in a serious accident around 6 p.m. Tuesday, Aug.29, on westbound Paseo del Norte. There was a slowdown and a motorcyclist struck the back of his pickup. The scene was grisly and the traffic implications were horrendous -- rush-hour Paseo was closed for hours as APD managed first the emergency response and then the accident investigation. But the first officers on the scene -- I only know there was a male and a female -- were amazing. They were professional yet compassionate, they shared information as to how the scene would be managed, they balanced rescue with traffic concerns, in short they were everything you want in a first responder to a horrible situation. The rest of the APD team -- and because this was a serious crash with life-threatening injury it was a big team -- was impressive as well. The DWI officers took the time to explain their role in the investigation, and again balanced being understanding with being professionals who have a job to do. My husband remains very shaken by the incident -- he held the injured motorcyclist while other motorists called 911 -- but the officers who were with him for the next four-plus hours made a horrible situation more bearable with their humanity, courtesy and professionalism. I have worked for the Albuquerque Journal since 1989, am currently the editorial page editor, and have written the traffic column since 2005. I tell you this only to let you know I am very familiar with all the department has gone through, the challenges inherent in an accident scene causing a bridge closure, and to emphasize that as an informed member of the media I am very impressed by and thankful for how very well your officers treated my husband while handling a demanding and serious scene.

What Outcome are you Seeking?

I would like this information shared with the officers' chain of command. They represented their department and their city extremely well in a demanding situation and deserve recognition. Yes, one can say they were "just doing their jobs," but their demeanor, compassion balanced with professionalism, and concern for all involved are admirable, and we would be lucky to have that replicated across the city.
