My 3 children and myself were trying to deal with a psychotic episode my wife was having. We were able to get her as far as the UNM psychiatric hospital parking lot but she refused to go in. That was when (as my 19 year old son later described it) "an Angel in the form of a policeman" happened to be walking by and assisted us. I am afraid I may be mangling his name, but I believe it was Andrew Ramskowski. He had the most amazing demeanor and was able to convince my wife to go in and get help. It is hard to put into words what that meant to my family; we have been dealing with my wife's mental illness for years, and resources are few and far between. As I told him as he walked away, he was truly a hero to us at that moment.

In mid-october of 2015 my husband and our 2 young daughters were staying with my biological mother. She attacked my husband (a former Iraq combat vet with severe PTSD/TBI) and locked us out of the house with our small children inside. When officers Apodaca and Olquist arrived, they explained what we all knew, it wasn't safe there. They could not keep my children safe if I chose to go back there. Of course this was a difficult thing, where were we to go? My husband had just gotten out of the Army and we were trying to settle down and get on our feet. Rather than let us and our children suffer the cold and sleep in the car, the officers paid for several nights at a motel 6 for us. Officer Lorenzo Apodaca even called to check on us, and bought my family pizza for dinner. I'll never forget that call. I was crying, and I said thank you. Thank you so much officer Apodaca. And he said to me "Call me Lorenzo. Only bad guys call me Officer. Take care of your babies. Everything will be ok."

While I believe most of APD makes the world a better place, this is an instance where I am still unsure whether these officers are human flesh and bone, or if they were sent via divine intervention.

What Outcome are you Seeking?

I would like these officers to be acknowledged for their good deeds. This was not a matter simply of APD mediating, this was 2 citizens going above and beyond for a family in need. Officer Apodaca and Officer Olquist saved our lives. They gave us hope when we had none, and they showed kindness and sincerity in a world where that is sorely lacking. I think of these officers daily, I pray for their safety and their comrades safety, and I hope that they know they have and continue to make the world a better place.

Over the last few months, there have been multiple incidents at the property listed above, which we manage. Due to some legal issues with the tenant there, we have had to let them remain in the property until the end of their term, which ends tomorrow, 31 December 2017 instead of an immediate eviction in October, when the issues first started.

Over the course of many, many, calls we have been interacted with no less than 4 of the area officers on day shift who have been professional, courteous, and beyond helpful in the interactions we've had with them.

Unfortunately, I wasn't paying enough attention to keep track of everyone's names, but I want to say thank you to the entire group. We want you to know we appreciate everything they've had to deal with regarding this tenant and her issues.
