Officer Wellford was extremely kind and helpful to me, who was the "victim". On Monday, 6/19/17 I spoke with him to thank him for his kindness shown to me. Also that day, he brought to me an incredible amount of written information as well as offering any help I may need. I asked him for the name and phone number of his supervisor. He provided me with Sgt. B. Paige phone number. I spoke with Sgt. Paige that day and told him how grateful I was and appreciated Officer Wellford's courteous & helpful ways.

My husband, told me about Officer Wellford who arrested him. He told me that the officer was very considerate; ensuring that was comfortable in the back seat with AC as it was very hot that day. Officer Wellford did not hand cuff had his walker and was in a lot of pain, which can be very extreme. said that the entire journey from our home to MDC was very pleasant with the officer who spent extra time on 's behalf. He ensured everything was helpful and comfortable for a 70+ year old man. My husband was diagnosed in 1992 by the SS Administration to have & received full disability benefits from the SS Admin. making him mentally disabled. He is a Vietnam Era Veteran, who also has and a variety of physical ailments.

Considering the situation, only had praise for Officer Wellford and shared this information with me. I shared it with Sgt. Paige via a phone conversation conveying my husband's feelings about Officer Wellford. I told him we were both appreciative of the APD and the fine officers who serve.

Sgt. Paige provided me with much info as well. I explained to him the negative treatment received at MDC and the harrowing experience he also had with I think BC who took over after left MDC. My husband never reached his destination as told to me by Dr. Diane Garcia of MDC & also listed on the Discharge Plan, but rather ended up at UNM Hospital Psych. Unit and was checked in with a high heart rate (first time), high blood pressure and extremely dehydrated and was treated by the physicians. Sgt. Paige provided me with additional information and told me to contact him if I needed further assistance. I am in the process of putting together a formal complaint against MDC & BC and whomever else was involved in the terrible experience of 6/18 (after Officer Wollford)& 6/19, 2017.

I am proud of APD. I know they have gotten some bad press. We all are learning and all need to know that what we do and how we speak is of immense importance. It makes impact whether it be positive or negative, we choose. Thank you, Officer Wellford & Sgt. Paige for your positive impact on us. We need you and we appreciate all that you do.

What Outcome are you Seeking?

For APD and for both Officer Wellford and Sgt. Paige to know that what they do is noticed by its citizens. For them to feel inspired by their own positive ways and continue to be a model of exemplary behavior. You are NEEDED & again THANK YOU.
