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

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### Additional Comments:

The investigation determined by a preponderance of the evidence that the alleged conduct occurred as D. B who is wheelchair-bound was placed into a patrol vehicle on the order of Sgt. H after being arrested, but doing so did not violate APD policies, procedures, or training. Mr. E was in the patrol vehicle for approximately twenty-seven minutes before being removed and placed onto a gurney. The investigation determined by a preponderance of the evidence that the alleged conduct occurred as C. B was arrested for battery on a police officer and negligent use of a deadly weapon among other things, but doing so did not violate APD policies, procedures, or training. The information that could be obtained judiciously was obtained during the preliminary investigation.
