The Albuquerque Museum and New Mexico Council of Car Clubs Automobile Show will be at the Albuquerque Museum, 2000 Mountain Rd. NW, on May 18, 2014. The show is open to antique, classic, sports, special interest, and modified vehicles; motorcycles, motor scooters, and vintage campers are welcome.

This year, the show will feature "75 Years of Mercury" and recognize "50 Years of GTO and Mustang." If you have a vintage Mercury, GTO or Mustang, and wish to be in this special display area, please e-mail [joyce@nmcarcouncil.net](mailto:joyce@nmcarcouncil.net) or call 884-7912.

Trophies will be awarded in many categories for vehicles 1989 and older (25 years old). Newer vehicles may be entered for display only.

All vehicles must pay a \$10 Registration Fee at the entrance to the show at 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Old Town Rd. There is no pre-registration. Please arrive no earlier than 7:00am. Except for the special display area, no spaces will be reserved. If you wish to park as a group, please arrive together.

No trailers are allowed on Old Town Rd. or 19<sup>th</sup> Street unless they are part of a display. Vehicles should be driven into the show area via Old Town Rd. If you need special arrangements for an oversized vehicle or one that needs pushing, please contact Joyce at the above e-mail or phone for special instructions.

Volunteers will be on 19<sup>th</sup> Street and in the parking lot to guide you to a parking space. Please follow their directions.

Between 8:30am and 10:00am, bring your registration paper and your window card to the Registration Table at the north end of the parking lot to receive your goody bag, which will contain your ballot, dash plaque, and Museum admission tickets. You must register your vehicle.

No Tents or Canopies are allowed on the show field or 19<sup>th</sup> Street by order of the Fire Marshal. No stakes are to be pounded into the lawn or parking areas.

Cars are to remain in place until 3:30pm. Awards take place starting at 3:30pm.

Special Automobile Art and Model Vehicle displays will be in the Museum Special Events Room inside the Museum. There is no charge to enter art or models in the displays, and there is no charge to visit the area. Security and liability are the responsibility of the entrant.

No "For Sale" signs are allowed. This is a Museum regulation. Please cooperate.
