

**NM COUNCIL OF CAR CLUBS-ALBUQUERQUE MUSEUM FALL CRUISE
NOVEMBER 8, 2020**

Welcome to this fall cruise of the Old Town area. This is not a timed event or a parade, but a leisurely drive through the area. You may cruise the route as many times as you wish. Leave the Museum parking lot singly or in groups of no more than 5 cars at a time. Please drive carefully and obey all traffic laws. Watch for pedestrians and slow traffic. Keep adequate distances between you and the cars ahead. Follow whatever COVID 19 rules are currently in place. Enjoy your drive.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS AND MAP

1. Exit the Museum parking lot and turn left on 19th St.
2. Go north to Mountain Rd. and turn left at the light.
3. Go west on Mountain, cross Rio Grande Blvd. and proceed to Montoya Rd. (just before Reginald Chavez Elementary School); turn left.
4. Follow Montoya to the Botanical Gardens and turn left (now labelled New York Ave.)
5. Turn right at the light on Central Ave. Be careful to avoid the ART bus lanes, and proceed to Tingley Dr. Turn left here (there is a light).
6. Follow Tingley south. There will be a block wall on your left that ends just before Alcalde. Make a hard left here, and follow Alcalde to Coal Ave. Turn right.
7. Turn left on 10th St.
8. Turn left on Park Ave.
9. At 14th St. turn right and head north.
10. At Lomas, turn right and head for the left turn lane at 12th St. Turn left here.
11. Follow 12th St. north, across Mountain Rd., and make a hard left onto Sawmill Rd.
12. Stay on Sawmill until it dead ends at 15th St. Turn left.
13. At Mountain Rd. turn right and go to light at 18th St. Turn right.
14. At Bellamah, turn left, proceed to 20th St. and turn left.
15. At Mountain Rd. turn left and go to light at 19th St.
16. Turn right, then right again into Museum parking lot.
