Tree of life Collage

The tree of life can be found in many religions and cultures of the world. It is a timely symbol that represents togetherness and reminds us that we are not alone, but connected to all people on earth.

Supplies Needed

- Construction paper
- Colorful papers with patterns, tear outs from magazines
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue
- Optional: office dot stickers in various colors

How to do it

1. Choose a paper with a solid color as your background so that there will be contrast with the patterned tree.
2. Look through your decorative papers and choose one to create the trunk and branches of you tree.
3. Fold your paper lengthwise and draw in pencil half of you tree along the fold.
4. After cutting along the pencil line, open the paper to see your perfectly symmetrical trunk and branches.
5. Choose from your other papers to create leaves, flowers, fruit, birdhouses etc. Cut your shapes, arrange on your tree and attach with glue.

Tip: By folding your paper several times before cutting out the shape, you will create multiples at once! You can also use office dot stickers of various colors.
