MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Vice Chair Estocin called the meeting to order on behalf of Chair Brittany Poss and confirmed that a quorum was present.

2. Approval of Agenda

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Chair Poss and seconded by Commissioner Feldman.

Motion approved unanimously.

3. Approval of April 17, 2026 Meeting Minutes

A motion to approve the April 17, 2026 meeting minutes was made, seconded, and approved unanimously.
