- iii. Bonnie commented current committees can write blurbs on what the subcommittee has done and what future plans include and see if there are volunteers.
- iv. Question on Bailey's position in supporting subcommittees
  - 1. Bailey can create agendas and post agendas and minutes if quorum is met
- v. Can only commission members chair/co-chair subcommittees?
  - 1. Alan with City Legal said typically only voting members chair the subcommittees
  - 2. In the past, voting members would chair and community members/other commission members could co-chair
  - 3. Chair moves to add training subcommittee and policy subcommittee additions to bylaws, making it 2 year term, nominations and transitions will happen in October.
    - a. Bonnie Escobar seconded. Motion approved 7-0. Bylaws will be amended and will be voted on next meeting
