### **DALE**

### **ODARA**

#### LAP 2.0 MNADV

Statewide fee \$7,500.00 per year

If a LAP implementers already exist the Statewide fee is \$7,500 annually, Multi-Jurisdictional \$5,000 annual and Single is \$2,500 annual.

VAWA funding is what led New Mexico to use this Lethality Assessment such as Valencia and Santa Fe.

Commission does not need to build curriculum as its already existing online and can be done in person.
