## Policy and Funding Subcommittee Meeting 12/20/23

## Discussion with guest speaker Representative Pamelya Herndon

- NM House Bill 27 (HB27)
  - NM House Committee discussing updates to the Extreme Risk Firearm Protective Order (ERFPO) process on 1/23/24 @ 1:30pm
  - ERFPO updates would include:
    - Allowing law enforcement and medical professionals to be reporting parties
    - A significant reduction in the window of time that respondents have to surrender their firearms after receiving the ERFPO
    - Formalizing a 24/7 on-call judge who officers could contact for an ERFPO at any time
    - Minor clarifications on details of the original bill
  - Rep. Herndon and many DV/SA service providers strongly support this legislation
- United States v. Rahimi -- US Supreme Court decision
  - Can the US government prohibit the restrained party on a domestic violence order of protection to have a firearm, or is that a violation of the restrained party's Second Amendment rights?
  - Oral arguments took place on November 15, 2023; the Supreme Court's opinion will be issued any day now
  - Rep. Herndon recommends that that Policy and Funding Subcommittee, if not the DVSA Commission as a whole, be prepared to issue a statement for either outcome
  - Rep. Herndon would like to reconvene with the Policy and Funding Subcommittee once the decision is finalized, so we can discuss next steps

## Funding requests to City Council for FY2025

- Isez and Ellen have been compiling data to inform the DVSA Commission's recommendation for funding for local DVSA service providers
- Those present for the call discussed their most significant gaps in services:
  - Increasing the number of staff at each agency, at basically every level
  - Staff retention
  - Prioritizing hiring additional case managers
  - Improving financial aid and other direct services for clients
  - Offsetting the upcoming federal cuts to VOCA funding
- Agencies will send Isez and Ellen a "wishlist" of priorities and estimated costs by January 2nd, 2024
