City Treasury Report(s) & Presentation – Cilia Aglialoro

• June received \$1.9M from Lodgers' and Hospitality. \$143K increase vs FY22.



- 10.92% Cumulative growth from FY22.
- Current Revenue grew 8.65% for Hospitality and Lodgers'.
- Direct Pay from STRs increased 3.79%
- Delinquent Lien Summary:
 - o 3 Hotels with liens
 - o \$15,093.04 in Delinquent Revenue.
 - o 11 Hotels with no payments, but few were turned into apartments.
 - o 34 hotels should be paying. 122 hotels actually paying in April 2023
 - o 194 Hotels paying directly.
- Short Term Rental Compliance/Non-Compliance
 - \circ 9/23/22 compliance rate 39%.
 - \circ From 3/7/23 7/5/23 compliant rate increased 16%, from 46% to 60% due to the letters sent to non-compliant STR's.
 - STR's labeled as non-compliant by the absence of correct registration and are not reporting Lodgers' collections.
