- Business Registration
 - o Ordinance changes now require annual business licenses (\$35 fee, \$10/day late fee).

 - o City inspector conducting outreach to expired/unregistered businesses with educational approach.
 - Transition issues noted (some businesses reporting conflicting renewal status).

 - o John Krumbacher introduced and provided background on his IT business and community involvement.
