- IV. City Permitting and Inspection Process Construction Industry Division Eddie Saiz, Local Business Owner It was a pleasure meeting you earlier today. As discussed we would very much appreciate having you attend next weeks' SBRAC meeting. At the request of the SBRAC Chairman, Anthony Trujillo I have added you to the meeting agenda as a discussion item. The realty of the host of inspection and permitting issues related to state project within the City or City project in the County is a topic very suited to the City's SBRAC.
- V. Scott Darnell, City Family and Community Services. In 2015, ABQ was selected to participate in Bloomberg Philanthropies' Innovation Teams program. Under this initiative, a local innovation team –known as the ABQ i-team –was established to work closely with the City and its private, non-profit, and public sector partners to bring a deeper understanding and new approaches to some of the most pressing challenges facing Albuquerque. ABQ Crime Concentration Research work was the I-team work presented to the SBRAC. Each SBRAC member was presented a copy of the presentation as a follow-up to the September 19 meeting.
- VI. **Board Term Update** Chris Tebo, City Legal, confirmed reviewed and confirmed the City ordinance governing boards and commissions set a standard term of service of two-terms. However the ordinance establishing SBRAC as passed allows for a maximum of three consecutive terms. Sect 2-6-1-5 provides for exceptions for boards or commissions with specific

provisions. SBRAC was established with a specific provision that outlines board term options of up to three consecutive terms (three years each).
