Serves notice to all parties.  
  
May cross-examine witnesses.

May submit non-technical oral testimony or evidence.  
  
May submit written statement in lieu of oral testimony to Hearing Clerk.

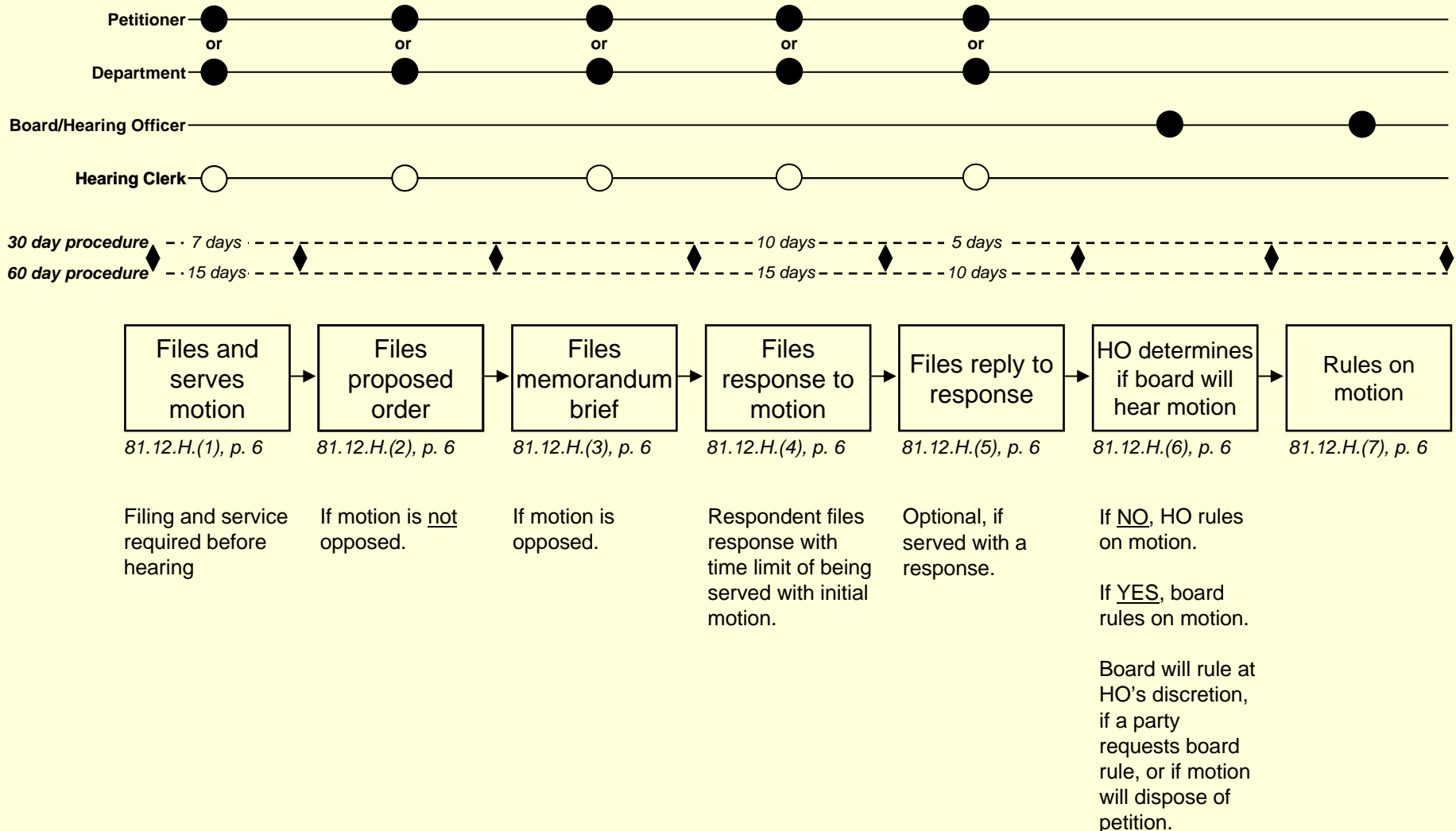
Petitioner has burden of proof.  
  
HO may allow oral or written testimony, exhibits, and examination of witnesses.

If directed by Board.  
  
Hearing Clerk forwards to Board and all parties.

HO, board member, board counsel, or party may prepare final order.  
  
Hearing clerk distributes final order.

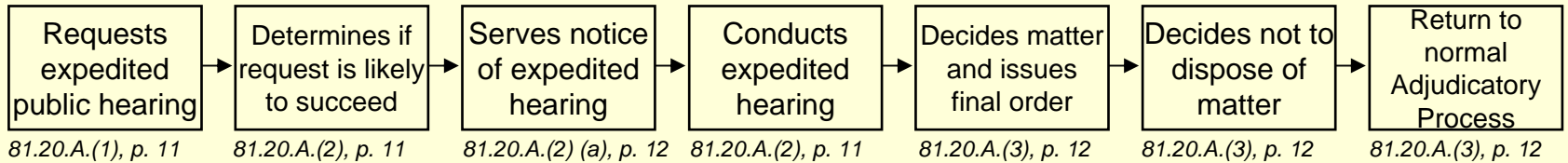
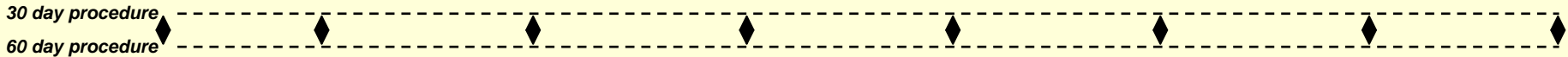
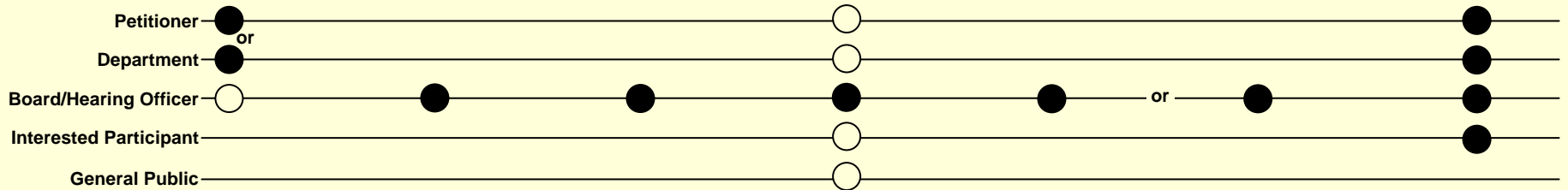

If NO, exit this process and return to normal Adjudicatory Process.

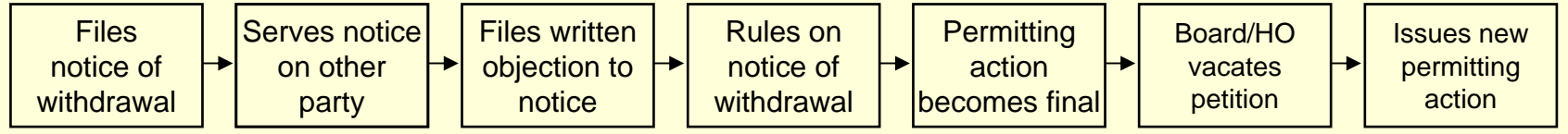
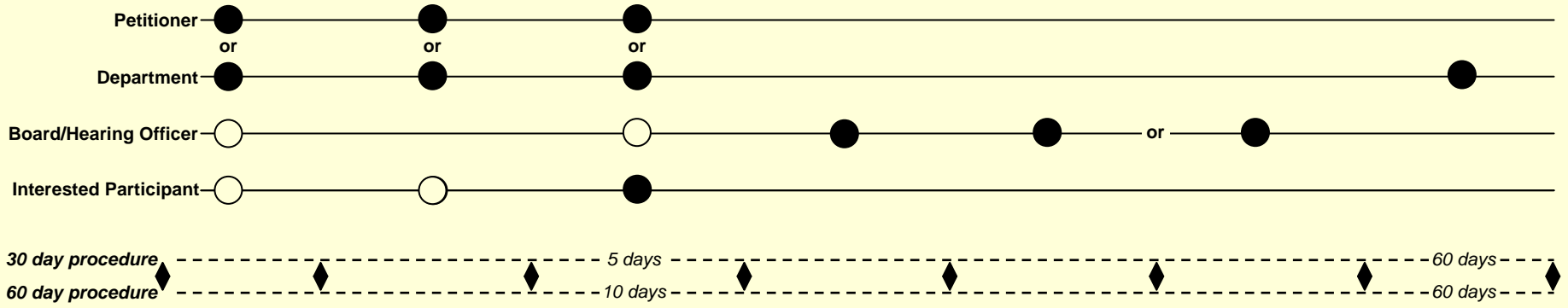
Requestor presents oral arguments and written briefs on legal arguments only.
