Authority & Roles of the EHD & the Air Quality Control Division

The City's Environmental Health Dept.

is the "local agency" for Air Board. Throughout Bernalillo County, EHD/AQD administers and enforces the federal Clean Air Act, the NM Air Quality Control Act, and the programs and regulations of the Air Board. EHD's authority & roles are delegated and limited by the Air Act and include:

Authority & Roles of the EHD & the Air Quality Control Division, cont.

- Monitoring air quality and reporting to the EPA & public
- Providing public notice, education and opportunities for meaningful public participation
- Meeting with people proposing to construct air contaminant sources. Issuing permits. Investigating. Instituting legal proceedings for violations & working with Legal to attain compliance and resolve the enforcement actions
- Operating the Vehicle Pollution Mgm Div & programs
- Classifying & recording air contaminant sources, and developing & presenting to the Board plans & regulations for controlling, preventing & abating air pollution

Duties of AQD attorney

The roles of AQD attorney include:

- Analyzing federal, state & local air quality laws
- With the Division's regulation development committee, reviewing and editing new regulations and amendments to present to the Air Board at hearings
- Representing AQD in enforcement actions involving violations of air quality permits and regulations
- Representing AQD before the Board
- **NOTE**: The AQD attorney does NOT provide legal advice to the Air Board. The AQD attorney attends Air Board meetings and represents AQD's positions on a variety of issues.
- Assistant City Attorney Donna Griffin is lawyer for the EHD Vehicle Pollution Management Division, and has handled certain air quality matters, although primarily is the lawyer for the non-air quality divisions of EHD
