Mr. Neal Butt, Environmental Health Scientist, presented the 2007 Regional SO2 Emissions and Milestone Draft Report (12/23/08). Motion was made by Member Grace to accept the report, seconded by Vice Chairman Deichmann, and was carried by a vote of 6-0.

- Item #5 Monthly Air Quality website update I. Tavarez

Mr. Fabian Macias, Environmental Health Manager, presented a new format illustrating the potential graphic representation of the air monitoring network.

Item #6 Update on Kirtland Air Force Base emissions stickers – G. Dennis

Mr. Glen Dennis, Manager for Vehicle Pollution Management Division, stated that he was currently in the process of contacting Colonel Duval from Kirtland AFB. He reported that Federal law requires individuals who access the Base 60 days a year or more, to comply with the local vehicle inspection and maintenance programs. He stated compliance with local vehicle maintenance and inspection programs may be accomplished by Base employers monitoring their employees. Member Sharpe inquired about the falsification of on-line vehicle inspection certifications. Mr. Dennis reported that the numbers of individuals participating in these activities were very low, but are being investigated at this time. He will report back in three months.

OTHER BUSINESS

Vice Chairman Deichmann reported that he and Chairman Minturn met with the Mountain View Neighborhood Association on January 22, 2009. He stated that once he and Chairman Minturn have reviewed their notes they will report back to the Board.
