Why Amend 20.11.21 NMAC, *Open Burning* ?

- **Regional Haze Rule, 2003**
- **BART, 2008**
- **SO₂ Milestones, 2010-11**
- **Improve rule**

Proposed Amendments to 20.11.21 NMAC, *Open Burning*

- **“Broadcast Burn”**
- **“Multiple event” vs. “single event” open burn permits**
- **Remove acknowledgement of receipt of applicant’s request for permit by EHD within 24 hours**
- **Reduce time ‘single-event permits’ remain valid**
- **Restrictions placed on burners by BCFD, AFD & IFC**
- **Restrict burning dead and dry weeds to comply with BCFD and AFD**
- **“Small-Scale Fire Extinguisher Training”**
- **Delete redundant language now codified in 20.11.81 NMAC, *Adjudicatory Procedures – AQCB***
- **Stylistic and formatting changes**
