Proposed Amendments to 20.11.21 NMAC, *Open Burning*

- **“Broadcast Burn”**
- **“Multiple event” v.s. “single event” open burn permits**
- **Remove acknowledgement of receipt of applicant’s request for permit by EHD within 24 hours**
- **Reduce time ‘single-event permits’ remain valid**
- **Restrictions placed on burners by BCFD, AFD & IFC**
- **Restrict burning dead and dry weeds to comply with BCFD and AFD**
- **“Small-Scale Fire Extinguisher Training”**
- **Delete redundant language now codified in 20.11.81 NMAC, *Adjudicatory Procedures – AQCB***
- **Stylistic and formatting changes**

Proposed Amendments to 20.11.21 NMAC, *Open Burning*

Authority

- **New Mexico Air Quality Control Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 74-2-4 and 74-2-5.B(1) [1967 as amended through 2007] authorizes and requires the Air Board to adopt, amend, or replace air quality regulations and to adopt air quality plans (SIPs) under NMSA 1978, Section 74-2-5.B(2)**
