## **Cleaning and Disinfecting for COVID-19**

What is novel coronavirus (COVID-19)? Ha'át'íí' Oólyé COVID-19 (Náhát'éí ts'áádah) Dooda go Ániidí Coronavirus da?

Dikos ndtsaahígí' ajéí yilzólii yaa nát'íí'go yiłnih Níłch'itsoh 2019 yihah dáá'áłtsé Bi'éé'lichí'ii –China di yił nih go ha deel íi'go' óolyé.

Novel coronavirus (COVID-19) is a new virus strain spreading from person-toperson. The virus originated in China but is currently spreading in the United States and other countries. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough, or trouble breathing. These symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after being exposed to the virus.

## Why should I wipe down surfaces?

Ha'á't'ííh biniyé' éí t'áá doolé'é bikáá góó dash t'ood doo?

Current evidence suggests that novel coronavirus can remain on surfaces for hours to days. **Cleaning** surfaces by removing dirt first and then **disinfecting** using a product to kill germs on surfaces can help prevent the spread of novel coronavirus.

## Steps for cleaning and disinfecting:

Kót'áó shííh hoji t'ood dóó bee táá há gisí azee bił ałtah ádaal yahígíí choo'í:

1. **Clean surfaces** using a detergent or soap and water. Removing visible dirt and debris will help disinfecting products work better.

2. **Disinfect surfaces** using a diluted bleach solution, an alcohol solution of at least 70% alcohol, or an EPA-registered household disinfectant or an EPA approved product effective against COVID-19. Follow <u>all</u> directions on the bottle as each disinfectant will have their own instructions.

- 3. NEVER mix products together. Tsídá bee táá da ha gisí díkwíí déé' al hih óóziid lá go.
  - o To make a bleach solution, mix:
  - o Bee' iil gáhá tó bił ałtah ájílééh gi:
    - 1/3<sup>rd</sup> cup of bleach (5 tablespoons) to 1 gallon of water OR Ashdla' béésh adee' ndtsaa'hígíí yikáłgo t'ááłá'í galóón tó ha giz bił ałtah ályaa doo dóó nááná
    - 4 teaspoons bleach to 1 quart of water Galóón haagiz ałníí' áníł tsóo hígíí díí' béésh adee' yázhí yikáł go tó' bił ałtah ázh doolííł.
- 4. Pay close attention to all frequently touched surfaces, such as, countertops, tables, and bathroom fixtures. Frequently touched objects such as, light switches, key pans, pens, remotes, and door handles, and frequently touched personal items, such as, phones, computer keyboards, tablets, and water bottles.

5. **Wash your hands** after cleaning and disinfecting using warm water and soap for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are unavailable, use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60% or more alcohol.

## What about cloth or fabric items?

Fabric items like, clothing, towels, bed sheets, and rugs, can be cleaned in a similar way. First, remove any dirt and debris. Do not shake items as this may cause any infectious particles to be released into the air. Then, wash items according to the manufacturer's directions. If possible, use warm water and dry completely. Make sure to wash your hands immediately after handling these items.
