Resources Committed and Underway

- 1. APD officers CIT-certified
- 2. Mental Health First Aid training

ACTION SUMMARY

Description of Actions Taken

- 95% of APD officers now CIT-certified
- 100 City-employees trained

LOW-HANGING ACTIONS

Minimal Resources to Implement

- 1. Support additional conversations
- 2. Promote mental health resources
- 3. Support reducing stigma
- 4. Services at Community Centers
- 5. Advocate for Medicaid reimbursements
- 6. Secure funding grants, foundations
- 7. Support affordable services/medications

ACTION SUMMARY

Description of Actions Taken

- Engaged in ongoing dialogues
- Items 2 and 3 are combined with promotion plans in development
- Center usage analysis underway
- Advocacy support underway
- Funding strategies in review
- Affordable care and AOT advocacy support underway

INTERMEDIATE ACTIONS

- 1. CIT training to first responders
- 2. Assess COAST staff and response times
- 3. Education on resources/information
- 4. Assess effectiveness of existing funding
- 5. After school programs for youth
- 6. Examine/prioritize long-term actions (See below)

ACTION SUMMARY

Action Team Recommendations

- AFD to CIT train all staff over next year
- Staff expanded, including 2 clinicians
- New brand/outreach plan developed
- Incorporated outcomes into RFPs
- Team formed/initial meeting in June
- Priority established: 3, 2, 5, 7, 6, 4, 1

Effort, Collaboration, Resources

LONG-TERM ACTIONS

- 1. Use Sun Van for transit to appointments
- 2. Support Community Engagement Teams
- 3. Support City/County-run triage center
- 4. Increase school-based health centers
- 5. Care coordination for MDC transitions
- 6. CYFD transition care for young adults ages 18 to 25
- 7. Increase behavioral health providers

Recommended Solution

- Available/enhance communications
- Plan established/legislation advocated

Some improvements are underway

- Tucson model/County tax increase
- Advocate for school-based services
- Recommend CYFD engagement continue beyond current age limit
- UNM provider inventory underway
