Housing Navigation

Description:

Housing Navigation service provides low barrier, trauma-informed overnight beds for transition to housing.

Outcome:

Successful exit to safe, stable housing and a plan for ongoing support.

Est. Annual Impact:

200 individuals expanding to 1000 individuals annually by 2025

Timeline:

Complete and open



Engagement Center

Description:

Engagement Center provides easy access to services needed for case management, job training, and supports needed.

Outcome:

Successful exit to safe, stable housing.

Est. Annual Impact:

200 individuals expanding to 1000 individuals annually by 2025

Timeline:

Complete and open



First Responder Receiving Area

Description:

Receiving Area for ACS and First Responders provides a low-acuity, 24/7 connection to shelter, housing and other services.

Outcome:

Provide a place for ACS and First Responders to take people in need.

Est. Annual Impact:

1,500 connections/ transports

Timeline:

Complete and open from 8:00 PM to 7:00am



Medical Sobering

Description:

Medical Sobering service provides low-acuity, medical monitoring to gain sobriety and serves as a complement to the CARES Campus.

Outcome:

Divert individuals from emergency departments and incarceration.

Est. Annual Impact:

17,000+ overnight stays

Timeline:

Mid 2024



Medical Respite

Description:

The Medical Respite service provides overnight patientcentered medical care and necessary social supports.

Outcome:

Reduce avoidable emergency department admissions; connect individuals to permanent supportive housing.

Est. Annual Impact:

320 Individuals

Timeline:

Late 2024
