Notice is hereby given that the City of Albuquerque (COA), Department of Family & Community Services has drafted its 2022 Ten Year Plan. The 1987 ordinance establishing the Housing and Neighborhood Economic Development Fund (HNEDF) called for the development of a ten-year comprehensive plan to outline and guide decisions about how to use revenues from loan repayments from HUD's Urban Development Actions Grants (UDAG) issued earlier that decade to support housing and economic development efforts in the area known as the Pocket of Poverty (the "Pocket"). Plans adopted in 1993 and 2002 have guided the use of over \$18M for housing and economic development projects benefiting Pocket residents between 1993 and 2008.

All residents, property owners, persons with disabilities, immigrants, seniors, low-income persons, children and youth, homeless persons, and other stakeholders in Albuquerque are invited to review the draft plan and comment on it in writing until April 28, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Comments may be submitted to: ykrantz@cabq.gov or Dept. of Family & Community Services, Community Development Division, Attn: Yolanda Krantz, P.O.
