# POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

At Inclusive Swim Hours, our primary goal is to provide a welcoming, fun, and safe environment for all participants. To help us achieve this, we ask everyone to follow these guidelines:

## Registration:

No preregistration necessary. Everyone attending must sign in upon arrival.

## Supervision:

Guardians and staff members must remain with the individuals they are supporting at all times.

## Code of Conduct:

Respectful behavior is expected at all times. Inappropriate language or actions will not be tolerated. Participants engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to step out of the pool or take a break from the program temporarily.

Proper swim wear is required to be in the water.

- Clean t-shirts and shorts are allowed on the pool deck, however patrons must have on proper swim attire underneath.

All participants that use diapers must wear proper swimmer diapers.

The following attire is not allowable swimwear:

- Street clothes, Brazil/French-cut, thong style and/or revealing swim wear, cut-off jeans, jeans, skirts, basketball shorts, leotards, leggings, dri-fit wear. Underwear and undergarments are not allowed to be worn under swimsuits.

Smoking and vaping are not permitted inside the facility or on city property.

Participants must follow all other pool rules.
